










This has been a gathering of scholarly people. Of course the gathering is to discuss a book, but in addition to that this has also taken the form of a Sabha gathered to discuss Artha Shastra.

In Indian Culture, Arthashasthra is an integral part. Artha isn't only about wealth, but Arthashasthra is also about discipline. The discussion that we witnessed on the occasion of release of book of Double Taxation was wonderful. To talk about 'Treaty', on a different occasion we had started some discussion and work on treaty. About 25 years back, we started a study on the topic of 'Cultural Treaty' of India with other foreign countries. At that time we were discussing with an IFS officer (Second) Shri Menon. There used to be one Mr.Menon before that. Then came KPS Menon and there was a third Menon, Shivshankar Menon. So it was the Second Menon (KPS) whom we spoke to. We requested information regarding the treaty that India signed with foreign nations on cultural relationships. We had requested copies of information on how much of implementation has happened over the years, the nations with whom this treaty has happened. There wasn't anything like Internet at that time. It was towards the end of the 80's where we started this discussion. I am mentioning about this incident here after I heard the word 'Treaty' and decided to share this piece of information. Anyway, the whole purpose of this gathering today is to discuss Treaties in Tax.

Treaty happens and becomes effective, when the two parties involved like each other, accept each other and when there is betterment for both parties in a wholehearted manner with positive output. Treaty is never one sided. It keeps in mind both sides. With regards to this, there have been a lot of people who have spoken today. About Nithishasthra <Neeti Shastra>, Arthashasthra, about how India needs to be in about 20 to 25 years, and a whole lot of valuable discussions by each individual we had today.

Mr. Rajaram explained how registrations for ships happen in smaller countries, and how that can be done in our country. Mr. Choudhri gave a wonderful explanation and interpretation on social order & individual's right and law of choices and what needs to be done in those situations. Every speaker today have all spoken eloquently on these topics. We have to conduct in future one more Sabha with such very noteworthy points raised in their speeches. Just like how Mr.Pai had mentioned and suggested, how women education is gaining momentum, and that men also need to be focussed. The topics discussed today have been about society, about law & order and a lot more and they have all been wonderful and it is essential to hold a forum such as this to invite detailed discussions and dialogue. And we can organize such a session in Kanchi.

It is heartening to see such a discussion of over two hours on a book. The book isn't about our scriptures, but on Taxation. And many may wonder about our participation in such a discussion of this duration. One reason which can be stated is that this book has been written by a devotee of the Math. Secondly, while we are adherents of Advaita philosophy, still, we run an institution. And to run an institution like this, we need to be aware of the happenings around the world and have a vision. For this we used to taken keen interest in scientific institutes and industries around 20 years ago, and have also been following happenings in the armed forces. We have also interacted and held discussions with those in service of government and with those who keep in close touch with common people of our nation.

These days we have started a Dharmic nursery program, a Dharmic environment so to say. In this we invest our time, just like how you have heard about investing money, through this initiative, we invest our time to ensure the strength and well-being of the future generation. To maintain our traditional values, to ensure they don't lag behind in the field of technology, whether it be the Chandraayan mission or Aditya Mission or any of the other multiple initiatives in the field of technology, our future generation always stays a step ahead. But more than anything, we ensure that we need focus on the vital aspect that makes our country. What is it, the aspect of Faith & Family Values. We must ensure that we never become weak in these aspects. We were actually a developed country at the beginning, then in the middle for about a 1000 years there was a lot of disturbance, because of which we distanced ourselves from our cultural values, maybe even got diverted from them and in the process diluted something that was so crucial to us. Hence we need to keep in mind that we focus on the Persona of India, The Science of India, the Beliefs of India, or the Knowledge House of India (Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan).

I have been here earlier as well in Bangalore for a book launch of a Kannada book written by Maddur Krishnamurthy. The book titled 'Deiva Vaani' was about Sri Sri Chandrashekarendra Saraswathi Maharaj, 68th Acharya of this peetam. The book sheds light on the Philosophies of the Swami, which was translated into Kannada. It was during this book launch that I was in Bangalore at the exact location where you are all gathered here today.

The subject of tax that was spoken about, is not a wrong concept. The interest that's collected, isn't wrong either. But one needs to understand how much is taken, from whom it is taken and the interest that's collected, where is it being invested. In the scriptures, the book Gauthama Dharma Sutra, mentions about economics. In the recent past, we've seen the happenings of the agriculturalists, where they have spoken about their struggles as how they are unable to pay high rate of interests that is imposed on them. Akin to that, there are certain aspects of economics mentioned in the Gauthama Sutra called 'Kusida' which is for welfare of one & all.

There is mention about the term Kusida i.e 'Interest' is even found in the vedas. (Quotes a line from the vedas mentioning Interest). This means the concept of tax and interest is as per Dharma. But, it is essential to know how much to charge, how much percentage to charge, how to make use of the revenue, all these aspects are also to be adhered. We know collecting tax from the citizens is the Dharma of the King in a kingdom. Similar to that there is Dharma in every person's life, every deed has a Dharma, every action,

every thought has a Dharma, there is Dharma in lending, there is Dharma in Medicine. Dharma is a very deep concept. Yet Dharma is sometimes simple. Dharma is generous & scientific. It becomes impossible to explain all these Dharmas in common terms. Dharma is a magnificent Science that is all encompassing. Topics such as Poverty, Divyanga - Specially challenged, Women, Illiterate, old age, have all been kept in mind. Similarly to that, one needs to deal with others with love, with dedication, responsibility and integrity all in the name of Dharma. Hence understanding Dharma isn't that easy. One can try and understand Dharma only stage by stage and that has been taught to us over generations with certain lifestyles based on Indian Value system that one needs to follow.

The Supreme Court has also discussed regarding this topic while talking about Hinduism. In Bharatiya Jeevit Vidan, there is mention of Artha Shastra, Dharma, Artha, Kama & Moksha and a balanced view is provided in that. समं वा त्रिवर्गम्। We should practice our Dharma. The nature of humans is to wish. They wish to have microphones like this, wish for lights like this, they wish for everything; there is a want to earn & also to spend. Hence there is space given for desire-Kama.

IAS Rajaram represents GIFT City. This work today is Gift through books! The proceeds from books in the form of royalty has been earmarked for the charitable activities of Sri Pratyaksha Charitable Trust, and the income generated would be invested in our Dharmic beliefs and trust. Through which there can be betterment to the society.

I have thought about three kinds of formation. First is the formation of Government, Secondly, formation of Society, and thirdly, formation of the Shastras. Development in the Government has happened and is consistently happening in the country thanks to our Democracy. I had spoken during one such gathering in Kanchi, about how in the last 75 years, we have saved our democracy and how it is time now to save the people and for that what has to be done and how do we go about it. Secondly when it comes to the Development of the Society, we need to identify people who lack basic amenities. We need to uplift them and help them. We have many such first generation graduates studying in our University in Kanchipuram. They have been constantly helped and looked after. The university doesn't operate on a profit making vision, but operates from a vision of Seva. Through these charitable offerings, our aim is to identify those who require such measures and provide better means and opportunities to them.

When one talks about Artha Sadhanam, we can go back and understand from our scriptures.

सेनापरिच्छदस्तस्य द्वयमेवार्थसाधनम्। शास्त्रेष्वकुण्ठिता बुद्धिः मौर्वी धनुषि चातता॥

Now we need to understand Ancient Science and Modern Science and identify the core concept that is being discussed in both. Secondly, it is mentioned in the scriptures about a king who used to Tax the citizens of his kingdom.

प्रजानामेव भूत्यर्थं स ताभ्यो बलिमग्रहीत्। सहस्रगुणमृत्स्रष्टमादत्ते हि रसः रविः॥

Why did he tax the people? He taxed them not to punish them, but instead for the betterment of the people. Yes, he has the authority & the power to tax and he can do it, that is besides the point. The king who takes the tax does this only to help his subjects and not for spending it on extravagant lifestyle. This tax is to focus on what's most important for the people, what would be best suited for the people, the King fixes these priorities based on what's best for the Kingdom, concerns that may arise in the future and how best to solve that, so that the people don't suffer.

The King plans these with an approach based on Equality, Gentle vision & Compassionate Vision and just like how the King has all these visions, the people also must understand this and share the vision. Just like how the Sun with its harsh rays, dries up the water from the earth, but instead of doing that for a selfish reason, the Sun then gives back the water thousand times more in the form of rain. Similarly, the time that we invest, the intelligence that we invest or the money that we invest, TIME, INTELLIGENCE & MONEY, whatever it may be, should be in the interest/ favour of the people, should be in the interest of Dharma. Dharma firstly is for everyone, the Dharma of every Yuga -Satya Yuga, Treta Yuga, Dwapara Yuga or Kali Yuga, some

Dharmas are such that its forever. When there is contradiction, there are enough information in the Scriptures about that as well. Information about which one to take & which one to let go, are also discussed in the scriptures. उत्तरोत्तरं बलीयः Similarly there's also a lot more. अभियुक्ततरेरन्येः अन्यथेव उपपाद्यते। Today someone has written something, tomorrow someone else will write a lot more on the subject. Hence, we can clearly understand that the thought can never be stopped. Scriptures have that power and have never stopped progression. So tomorrow, another intellectual soul, can always write more. So think about the good that you can do to the society and function accordingly. That is the nature of the society that we live in. Indian society is open to accept new things and willing to protect and uphold the traditions and ancient values. Hence with Equality of vision, Gentle vision & Compassionate vision, how do we then see the world, how much would we be able to see, what would be our approach हिकोण. Is it only कोणहिए blurred vision or an approach हिकोण? What is it? The vision that our country has is that of Truth. A vision of Truth. A vision to investigate the truth. To investigate the absolute Concept of Truth.

These days you are all familiar with Animation, but those days it was अन्वेषण - Investigation. Where is it, where is it, what is it? That was all the questions we were investigating with. Some of the learned Gurus in the past investigated all the concepts and dug deep and filtered out the Truth from all the falsity and made that their Principle focus. Basically we are not against research. But along with research there also has to be enormous amounts of Devotion & Trust. This research in addition to devotion & trust would hugely benefit the people and future of our country, as mentioned in the Artha Shastra by many people. Economic Development & destruction of Terrorism/violence should be done in the society. With regards to this, I had given a speech in 2002 in Delhi at the Siri Fort Auditorium, during the Shankaracharya & National integration seminar. Economic Development & end to violence should happen, for benefit & security of the nation. As in, the stance of the nation, the stability and ability of the nation should not diminish. The friendly relationships that our nation shares with our neighbouring nations should also not be tarnished. Our nation always shares a great equation with other nations, likewise the view of other nations towards India should also be noble & friendly. There should be room for the likes of 'Bakasura' or Bhasmasura. Hence the safety of our nation, the knowledge from our nation and the wealth of talent of this nation becomes useful to the others around the world. Because the core ideology of our country is equality समदर्शिता and excellence पारदर्शिता. Just getting a certificate is not the intention of Gurukuls of India.

The schools in India teaches this attitude that enables us to reach the goal of knowledge. You can read the fine print, it doesn't mention that just study for five years or seven years, and you've completed your education, or you've graduated, that isn't the case. Graduation does happen eventually, but it only teaches you to study and gain even more knowledge.

आचार्यात् पादमादत्ते पादं शिष्यः स्वमेधया। पादं सब्रह्मचारिभ्यः पादं कालक्रमेण च॥

(Meaning-One learns a quarter percent of knowledge from a teacher, a quarter is self acquired, a quarter is imbibed from fellow students and the final quarter is learnt as life progresses)

There are four types of correct knowledge, just like what Justice had mentioned, about what he did in Bangalore, then what he experienced when he was in the bench in Delhi, similarly others in the gathering today have also shared their opinions and thoughts and it has been a mix of highly learned members. For the betterment of our nation, we need Dharma and a Dharmic Aptitude. There has to be Dharma in Business but not Business in Dharma. Dharma in business is only possible when even the foreigners and the people around the world living in different countries, like it was discussed earlier about how the French would approve of something & how the Americans would think about something else, but the most important aspect is that there has to be Humanity in this world. For what reason there is power, for what reason government exists, how to do welfare for the people has to be though and there has to be a World Humanitarianism as a primary aspect. The democracy that we have here in India is a great thing. But the democracy has to always result in positive results. Everyone gets an opportunity thanks to democracy, but these opportunities should be used for the betterment of everyone and for that betterment of the nation.

Our Kanchi Math also contributes towards Knowledge, Medicine & Vedas. In the field of Medicine, the Math manages 10-15 Eye Hospitals. In the field of Knowledge, the speakers have already said a lot. In the field of Vedas, the work that was once done by Rajas and Maharajas, our grandfathers and great grandfathers, as Pai had mentioned, to protect the cultural values, there has been a very special effort that's being worked on. Through which our identity could be maintained. We can ensure our uniqueness to last. To ensure we can continue all this, we have the Culture Infrastructure Program. Keeping this Infrastructure Program in mind, the many temples that are present, we need to identify temple related personnel and we would be training them. These could be ones who make the Prasad, could be exponents of Puranas & epics, or musicians, could be sculptors, or the ones offering the prayers. Recently in Kerala, thanks to efforts of Mr.Pai and other donors, there has been a Deva Puja scheme aimed to benefit the village Archakas. They want to expand such Deva Puja Scheme in UP. Village Dharma Development, a program through which development of temples in such villages can be done. Similar such work is also being conducted in the North-East. Wherever there is a necessity, we get the work done in those places, places that already have a slight presence, we ensure we assemble our team there to work on the betterment of the Dharma and the betterment of the society. To ensure through these programs there is peace and prosperity for everyone. To ensure the legacy of our earlier generation continues, be it the ones who followed historical traditions or the ones following more recent traditions, we are working on a balanced approach, which takes the essence of ancient traditions and working on how it can improve and transform the current society. And I pray that more and more people work towards this goal, and I pray that the divine almighty showers everyone present at this gathering with his blessing for a long and prosperous life. And going forward, I hope there is a national interest towards this cause. We would need a non political leadership that would work to protect the unity of this country, to protect the culture of this country, and work to protect equality & balance of the society. Once we have that, we would always be ahead in Science, we would always be a trusted source when it comes to our scriptures like before and we would also be able to maintain our art & art forms like music and bharathnatyam. We would be able to maintain our hold on Yoga & the many practices, and most importantly we would need to take the core concepts from all these topics & then we would be able to lead a peaceful life co-existing with other people and communities.

Our country does not celebrate hatred. Just as honey bees collect honey from everywhere, we too should take all the good from everywhere and contribute to the over security, welfare and progress of one & all.

सर्वे भवन्तु सुखिनः सर्वे सन्तु निरामयाः। सर्वे भद्राणि पश्यन्तु मा कश्चिदुदुःखभाग्भवेत्॥

His Holiness then reads various quotes from scriptures which talk about economic concepts of tax and interest workings. His Holiness mentions the Rigvedic reference too. Going on, His Holiness talks about Rama who is described in Ramayana as an expert in income and expenditure

workings आयकर्मण्युपायज्ञः संदृष्टव्ययकर्मवित्।.

His Holiness concluded thus:

We have to invest more time & energy in Dharma & Bhakti and pray to Bhagavan to make India an abode of peace and progress. (शान्तिक्षेत्र & विकसितक्षेत्र)



It is a land of adhunik and adhyatmik Vidya (contemporary and traditional education) - several critical editions have been published pertaining to our Santana Dharma from Maharashtra. It is a sethu (bridge) between the North and South - the Marathi rules of Thanjavur have been closely connected with the Kanchi Math.

Our Pujya Paramcharya - Pujyashri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Mahaswamiji even at his advance age in his

80s went on Padayatra for a length of more than 5000 kms traversing through several villages of Maharashtra. He blessed and established the Uttar Chidambaram Nataraj Mandir in Satara- the temple serves as a symbol of unity with participation of the Governments of Maharashtra, Kerala, Andhra and Tamilnadu. Adi Shankaracharya - inspired feeling of unity with his yatras from Kalady to Kamakhya - Kanchi to Kashi and Kathmandu. Sri Govinddev Giriji had the blessings of Pujya Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamiji at - Paithan also called Pratishta Nagari - from there to Bala Ram pratishta has been a great spiritual journey.



In our dharma, we have our faith everywhere, in nature, in cows, trees, Teertha Kshetras and especially in vigraha & Murti pujan. On 22nd January, Subakrut - Poushya Maas - Shukla Dwadashi- Samovar - murti Chaitanya was instilled.

Svatantra is required for our swadharma.

Adi Shankaracharya in Bhajagovindam says गेयं गीता नाम सहस्रं - Geyam gita nama sahasranam - we must imbibe the Bhagavad Gita and chant Vishnu Sahasranamam.

With the blessings of Pujyashri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Sawmiji and with his Margadarshan and Prerana, Sri Govinddev Giri Maharaj has dedicated himself to four types of work - spreading the message of Bhagavad Gita across the world, Veda Raksha through establishing Veda Patashalas, taking our works into various swadeshi languages, and instilling Desh Bhakti - Swardharm ka Samrakshan.


Acharya Swamigal visits visit to Ahobilam (28-Feb-2024)




Aradhana of 67th Acharya performed at Tirupati (10-Mar-2024)




Aradhana Mahotsavam of Pujyahsri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal commences at Kanchipuram (20-Mar-2024)




ATM sloka parayanam members chanted Abirami Andhadhi on Thai Amavasai day 9-02-2024 and made the day so divine for all ATM Group members.
